

Probate Notes for September 17, 2014

Probate notes are a recommendation as to the outcome of the petition. Unlike tentative rulings, they do not automatically become adopted as the order of the court. Unless an appearance at the hearing is otherwise required by law, if petitioner submits a proposed order prior to the hearing and the recommendation is to grant the petition, no appearance is necessary. If you are scheduled to appear and there is no probate note issued in your case, you should appear as scheduled. If you wish to continue a matter, you must contact the civil division at (530) 406-6704, at least two (2) court days before your hearing.

Please note: The following probate matters will be heard in **Department Two at 9:00 a.m.**

CASE: Conservatorship of Siegel
Case No. CV PC 14-140

The Court notes the following deficiency: Proof that the notice of hearing has been served on the required parties has not been filed with the Court. (Prob. Code, § 1822.)

The parties are **DIRECTED TO APPEAR** for appointment of legal counsel for the proposed conservatee. (Prob. Code, §§ 2356.5, subd. (l), 1470 et seq.)

CASE: Conservatorship of Threet
Case No. CV PC 10-35

The parties are **DIRECTED TO APPEAR.**

CASE: Estate of Orosco
Case No. CV P2 14-130

The Court notes the following deficiencies:

1. Petitioner fails to state the amount of bond she seeks to have fixed by the Court.
2. The *Duties and Liabilities of Personal Representative* form must be filed with the Court (Judicial Council of California Form DE-147).

CASE: Estate of Patchen
Case No. CV PB 14-132

The Court notes the following deficiency: Paragraph eight of the petition does not list Michelle Roesch as a person mentioned in decedent Cheryl Roesch Patchen's will.

CASE: Estate of Ryan
Case No. CV PB 14-146

The Court notes the following deficiency: Proof of publication must be filed prior to the hearing. (Prob. Code, § 8120 et seq.)

CASE: Estate of Smith
Case No. CV PB 13-162

The Court notes the following deficiency: Petitioner fails to provide a waiver of account by Carl Smith as indicated in the petition. (Prob. Code, § 10954.)
