

Amended Probate Notes for October 10, 2014

Probate notes are a recommendation as to the outcome of the petition. Unlike tentative rulings, they do not automatically become adopted as the order of the court. Unless an appearance at the hearing is otherwise required by law, if petitioner submits a proposed order prior to the hearing and the recommendation is to grant the petition, no appearance is necessary. If you are scheduled to appear and there is no probate note issued in your case, you should appear as scheduled. If you wish to continue a matter, you must contact the civil division at (530) 406-6704, at least two (2) court days before your hearing.

Please note: The following probate matters will be heard in **Department Two at 9:00 a.m.**

CASE: Conservatorship of Anderson
Case No. CV PC 08-01

The Court notes the following deficiencies:

1. Petitioners' failed to file a proper proof of service establishing that the notice of hearing was served on all required parties.
2. An acknowledgment of receipt of the *Duties of Conservator and Acknowledgement of Receipt of Handbook* form has not been filed with the Court. (Prob. Code, § 1834; Cal. Rules of Court, rule 7.1051.)

CASE: Conservatorship of Aragon
Case No. CV PC 13-154

It is recommended to approve the court investigator's report and first verified account and report of conservator. (Prob. Code, § 1850 et seq.)

CASE: Conservatorship of Dorman
Case No. CV PC 11-183

Due to the death of the conservatee, the conservatorship of the person terminated, by operation of law, on June 8, 2014.

It is recommended to approve the verified second and final account and report of the conservator and to grant the petition for discharge upon the filing of a final declaration with the Court showing that the remaining estate assets, if any, have been properly delivered. (Prob. Code, §§ 2467, 2620 et seq.; Judicial Council form DE-295/GC-395.)

CASE: Conservatorship of Feld
Case No. CV PC 14-161

On the Court's own motion, the matter is **CONTINUED** to Friday, November 7, 2014, at 9:00 a.m. in Department 2 for completion of the court investigator's report.

**CASE: LPS Conservatorship of Flup
Case No. LP SQ 14-39**

It is recommended to grant the petition for appointment of conservator of the person and the estate. (Welf. & Inst. Code, § 5350 et seq.)

**CASE: Conservatorship of Laquard
Case No. CV PC 14-156**

On the Court's own motion, the matter is **CONTINUED** to Friday, November 7, 2014, at 9:00 a.m. in Department 2 for completion of the court investigator's report.

**CASE: Conservatorship of Mackin
Case No. CV PC 11-187**

It is recommended to approve the court investigator's report and second verified account and report of conservator. (Prob. Code, § 1850 et seq.)
