

Probate Notes for February 18, 2015

Probate notes are a recommendation as to the outcome of the petition. Unlike tentative rulings, they do not automatically become adopted as the order of the court. Unless an appearance at the hearing is otherwise required by law, if petitioner submits a proposed order prior to the hearing and the recommendation is to grant the petition, no appearance is necessary. If you are scheduled to appear and there is no probate note issued in your case, you should appear as scheduled. If you wish to continue a matter, you must contact the civil division at (530) 406-6704, at least two (2) court days before your hearing.

Please note: The following probate matters will be heard in **Department Two at 9:00 a.m.**

CASE: Conservatorship of Hoyt
Case No. CV PC 12-139

The Court notes the following deficiencies:

1. The conservator failed to file the required accounting as ordered by the Court on June 3, 2014, and January 14, 2015. (Prob. Code, § 2620.)
2. Attorney Charles Jensen did not file a response to the investigator's report as ordered by the Court on November 19, 2014.

The parties are **DIRECTED TO APPEAR.**

CASE: Conservatorship of Lindsey
Case No. CV PB 05-262

The Court notes that the conservatorship has not been reviewed since Matthew and Elaine Lindsey were appointed as conservators of the person and estate of Jennifer Lindsey on February 14, 2006. Prior to considering the conservators' petition for substituted judgment to create and fund a special needs trust for the conservatee, the Court requires the conservatorship to be reviewed.

Therefore, on the Court's own motion, this matter is set for an annual review on Wednesday, April 8, 2015, for the purpose of reviewing an accounting and the court investigator's report. (Prob. Code, §§ 1850, 2620.) Conservators are directed to serve and file an accounting of the conservatorship estate pursuant to Probate Code section 2620.

CASE: Estate of Orosco
Case No. CV P2 14-130

It is recommended to deny Aida E. Ramirez's petition to determine that decedent died having a claim to the real located at 840 Lexington Way in Woodland, California. Petitioner fails to provide any evidence to support her petition.
