

Probate Notes for March 19, 2015

Probate notes are a recommendation as to the outcome of the petition. Unlike tentative rulings, they do not automatically become adopted as the order of the court. Unless an appearance at the hearing is otherwise required by law, if petitioner submits a proposed order prior to the hearing and the recommendation is to grant the petition, no appearance is necessary. If you are scheduled to appear and there is no probate note issued in your case, you should appear as scheduled. If you wish to continue a matter, you must contact the civil division at (530) 406-6704, at least two (2) court days before your hearing.

Please note: The following probate matters will be heard in **Department Two at 9:00 a.m.**

CASE: LPS Conservatorship of Honey
Case No. PB 88-18948

The Court notes the following deficiencies:

1. The petition is not verified.
2. It is unclear to the Court where the conservatee currently resides. The petition was served on conservatee at Skypark Gardens in Sacramento. However, the proposed order states that conservatee resides at Rosewood Care Center in Yuba City. Further, petitioners fail to indicate whether the petition was transmitted to the facility where the conservatee resides. (Welf. & Inst. Code, § 5361.)

CASE: Conservatorship of Pierson
