

## Probate Notes for April 3, 2015

Probate notes are a recommendation as to the outcome of the petition. Unlike tentative rulings, they do not automatically become adopted as the order of the court. Unless an appearance at the hearing is otherwise required by law, if petitioner submits a proposed order prior to the hearing and the recommendation is to grant the petition, no appearance is necessary. If you are scheduled to appear and there is no probate note issued in your case, you should appear as scheduled. If you wish to continue a matter, you must contact the civil division at (530) 406-6704, at least two (2) court days before your hearing.

**CASE:            Conservatorship of Hirsch**  
**Case No. CV PC 10-200**

On the Court's own motion, the matter is **CONTINUED** to Friday, July 10, 2015, at 9:00 a.m. in Department 2 for completion of the court investigator's report.

**CASE:            Conservatorship of Kulmann**  
**Case No. CV PC 14-129**

Matthew S. Crider's motion to be relieved as counsel for temporary conservatee Kathy Guerrero is **DROPPED FROM CALENDAR**. A substitution of attorney was filed on March 23, 2015.

The parties are **DIRECTED TO APPEAR** for the continued hearing on Kathy Guerrero's request that Charles Kulmann be deemed indigent.
