

## Probate Notes for June 3, 2015

Probate notes are a recommendation as to the outcome of the petition. Unlike tentative rulings, they do not automatically become adopted as the order of the court. Unless an appearance at the hearing is otherwise required by law, if petitioner submits a proposed order prior to the hearing and the recommendation is to grant the petition, no appearance is necessary. If you are scheduled to appear and there is no probate note issued in your case, you should appear as scheduled. If you wish to continue a matter, you must contact the civil division at (530) 406-6704, at least two (2) court days before your hearing.

**CASE:            Conservatorship of Cooper**  
**Case No. CV PC 15-08**

It is recommended to grant the petition for appointment of limited conservator of the person. (Prob. Code, § 1820 et seq.) The parties are **DIRECTED TO APPEAR** for the appointment of counsel for the proposed conservatee as recommended in the court investigator's report.

**CASE:            Conservatorship of Foster-Flippo**  
**Case No. CV PC 15-59**

It is recommended to grant the petition for appointment of probate conservator of the person. (Prob. Code, § 1820 et seq.)

**CASE:            Conservatorship of Zavala**  
**Case No. CV PC 15-77**

It is recommended to grant the petition for appointment of limited conservator of the person. (Prob. Code, § 1820 et seq.) The parties are **DIRECTED TO APPEAR** for the appointment of counsel for the proposed conservatee as recommended in the court investigator's report.

**CASE:            Estate of Burright**  
**Case No. CV PB 13-27**

It is recommended to grant the petition for first and final account and report of executor, for allowance of statutory compensation for attorney fees, and for final distribution and settlement of the estate. (Prob. Code, § 11600 et seq.)

**CASE:            In the Matter of the Pflanz Family Trust**  
**Case No. CV P2 15-76**

It is recommended to grant the unopposed petition to modify the trust based on changed circumstances. (Prob. Code, §§ 15409, subd. (a), 17200, subd. (b)(13).) Petitioner is directed to submit a proposed order prior to the date of the hearing.

**CASE:            In the Matter of the Zanchettini Family Trust**  
**Case No. CV P2 15-35**

It is recommended to grant Marilyn Zanchettini's petition to terminate the Zanchettini Family Trust, dated January 29, 2000. (Prob. Code, §§ 15404, 17200(b)(13).)
