

Probate Notes for July 10, 2015

Probate notes are a recommendation as to the outcome of the petition. Unlike tentative rulings, they do not automatically become adopted as the order of the court. Unless an appearance at the hearing is otherwise required by law, if petitioner submits a proposed order prior to the hearing and the recommendation is to grant the petition, no appearance is necessary. If you are scheduled to appear and there is no probate note issued in your case, you should appear as scheduled. If you wish to continue a matter, you must contact the civil division at (530) 406-6704, at least two (2) court days before your hearing.

CASE: Conservatorship of Arce
Case No. CV P2 06-161

The Court notes the following deficiency: the conservator failed to file the required accounting as ordered by the Court on July 5, 2013. (Prob. Code, § 2620.)

On the Court's own motion, the matter is **CONTINUED** to August 14, 2015, at 9:00 a.m. in Department 2 for completion of the court investigator's report.

CASE: Conservatorship of Archuleta
Case No. CV PC 08-113

The Court notes the following deficiency: the conservator failed to file the required accounting as ordered by the Court on July 5, 2013. (Prob. Code, § 2620.)

On the Court's own motion, the matter is **CONTINUED** to August 14, 2015, at 9:00 a.m. in Department 2 for completion of the court investigator's report.

CASE: Conservatorship of Black
Case No. CV PC 12-61

It is recommended to approve the court investigator's report. (Prob. Code, § 1850 et seq.) It is also recommended to waive future accountings so long as the conditions of Probate Code section 2628(a) continue to be met.

It is recommended to approve the court investigator's report and second verified account and report of conservator. (Prob. Code, §§ 1850 et seq., 2620, 1060.)

CASE: LPS Conservatorship of Treacher
Case No. LP SQ 15-34

The Court notes the following deficiencies: The comprehensive report of the conservatorship investigating officer has not been filed with the Court and served on the requesting physician, proposed conservator, and proposed conservatee, as required. (Welf. & Inst. Code, § 5354 et seq.)
