

Probate Notes for July 28, 2015

Probate notes are a recommendation as to the outcome of the petition. Unlike tentative rulings, they do not automatically become adopted as the order of the court. Unless an appearance at the hearing is otherwise required by law, if petitioner submits a proposed order prior to the hearing and the recommendation is to grant the petition, no appearance is necessary. If you are scheduled to appear and there is no probate note issued in your case, you should appear as scheduled. If you wish to continue a matter, you must contact the civil division at (530) 406-6704, at least two (2) court days before your hearing.

Please note: The following probate matters will be heard in **Department Two at 9:00 a.m** unless stated otherwise.

CASE: Conservatorship of Stevens
Case No. CV PC 08-111

Due to the death of the conservatee, the conservatorship of the person terminated, by operation of law, May 31, 2015.

CASE: Estate of Snipes
Case No. CV P2 15-107

It is recommended to grant John Meeker's petition for an order to establish and fund the Mary Ann Snipes Special Needs Trust. (Prob. Code, § 4541, subd. (b), 42 U.S.C. § 1396p(d)(4)(A).) Petitioner is directed to submit a proposed order prior to the date of the hearing.

CASE: Estate of Arleo
Case No. CV PB 08-137

It is recommended to approve Anthony Pesola's petition for an order approving the settlement agreement. (Prob. Code, § 9837.)
