

Probate Notes for July 30, 2015

Probate notes are a recommendation as to the outcome of the petition. Unlike tentative rulings, they do not automatically become adopted as the order of the court. Unless an appearance at the hearing is otherwise required by law, if petitioner submits a proposed order prior to the hearing and the recommendation is to grant the petition, no appearance is necessary. If you are scheduled to appear and there is no probate note issued in your case, you should appear as scheduled. If you wish to continue a matter, you must contact the civil division at (530) 406-6704, at least two (2) court days before your hearing.

Please note: The following probate matters will be heard in **Department Two at 9:00 a.m.**

CASE: Conservatorship of Contreras
Case No. CV PC 15-11

The Court notes the following deficiency: Petitioner failed to file a proposed *Order Appointing Court Investigator* (form GC-330). (Petition, ¶ 13.)

CASE: Conservatorship of Vargas
Case No. CV PC 15-26

The parties are **DIRECTED TO APPEAR** for the continued hearing on the petition for appointment of limited conservator, as ordered by the Court on May 21, 2015. The Court notes that a confidential written report of the regional center's findings and recommendations has not been filed with the Court. (Prob. Code, § 1827.5.) Additionally, the regional center's report has not be mailed, at least five days prior to the hearing, to the proposed conservatee and the petitioner, or attorney of the petitioner. (Ibid.)
