

Probate Notes for September 8, 2015

Probate notes are a recommendation as to the outcome of the petition. Unlike tentative rulings, they do not automatically become adopted as the order of the court. Unless an appearance at the hearing is otherwise required by law, if petitioner submits a proposed order prior to the hearing and the recommendation is to grant the petition, no appearance is necessary. If you are scheduled to appear and there is no probate note issued in your case, you should appear as scheduled. If you wish to continue a matter, you must contact the civil division at (530) 406-6704, at least two (2) court days before your hearing.

Please note: The Yolo Superior Court is now located at 1000 Main Street, in Woodland. The following probate matters will be heard in **Department Eleven at 9:00 a.m.**

CASE: Conservatorship of Kenworthy
Case No. CV PC 14-92

It is recommended to approve the court investigator's report. (Prob. Code, § 1850 et seq.)

CASE: Conservatorship of Odenweller
Case No. CV PC 15-112

It is recommended to grant the petition for appointment of probate conservator of the person. (Prob. Code, § 1820 et seq.)

CASE: Estate of Ringcamp
Case No. CV PB 14-179

John Scaccia has failed to file proof that the amended objection and amended memorandum in support of the contest of the Will dated May 1, 1998, were served on the required parties. (Prob. Code, § 1000, Code Civ. Proc, § 1010 et seq.)

To the extent John Scaccia's objection contests the right of Brian Scaccia to be appointed as personal representative, John Scaccia has failed to file a petition which asserts the right of an alternative person to be appointed as personal representative as required. (Prob. Code, § 8004, subd. (a).)

Further, John Scaccia has failed to establish that the summons issued on June 23, 2015, was served as required. (Prob. Code, §§ 8004, subd. (b), 8250.)

CASE: In the Matter of the Marion Meyer Revocable Trust
Case No. CV P2 15-123

It is recommended to grant the unopposed petition to confirm assets to trust. (Prob. Code, § 850 et seq; *Estate of Heggstad* (1993) 16 Cal.App.4th 943.)

**CASE: In the Matter of the Russell and Loretta Miller Revocable Trust
Case No. CV P2 15-134**

On the Court's own motion, the matter is **CONTINUED** to Tuesday, September 29, 2015, at 9:00 a.m. in Department 11 so that the Court may more thoroughly consider the petition filed by Debra Goss.
