

## Probate Notes for September 17, 2015

Probate notes are a recommendation as to the outcome of the petition. Unlike tentative rulings, they do not automatically become adopted as the order of the court. Unless an appearance at the hearing is otherwise required by law, if petitioner submits a proposed order prior to the hearing and the recommendation is to grant the petition, no appearance is necessary. If you are scheduled to appear and there is no probate note issued in your case, you should appear as scheduled. If you wish to continue a matter, you must contact the civil division at (530) 406-6704, at least two (2) court days before your hearing.

The Court notes the following deficiency: The original billing statements from the residential care facility that conservatee resides in have not been filed with the Court. (Prob. Code, § 2620, subd. (c)(5).) Petitioner is directed to submit a proposed order prior to the date of the hearing.
