

Probate Notes for September 30, 2015

Probate notes are a recommendation as to the outcome of the petition. Unlike tentative rulings, they do not automatically become adopted as the order of the court. Unless an appearance at the hearing is otherwise required by law, if petitioner submits a proposed order prior to the hearing and the recommendation is to grant the petition, no appearance is necessary. If you are scheduled to appear and there is no probate note issued in your case, you should appear as scheduled. If you wish to continue a matter, you must contact the civil division at (530) 406-6704, at least two (2) court days before your hearing.

Please note: The Yolo Superior Court is now located at 1000 Main Street, in Woodland. The following probate matters will be heard in **Department Eleven at 9:00 a.m.**

CASE: Conservatorship of Zaragoza
Case No. CV PC 15-133

It is recommended to grant the petition for appointment of probate conservator of the person and estate. (Prob. Code, § 1820 et seq.) Petitioner is directed to submit a proposed order prior to the date of the hearing.

CASE: Estate of Ryan
Case No. CV PB 14-146

It is recommended to grant the petition for final distribution on waiver of accounting, for allowance of statutory compensation to the attorney for ordinary services, and for final distribution and settlement of the estate. (Prob. Code, § 11600 et seq.)

CASE: In the Matter of the Althaea Montano Trust
Case No. CV P2 15-153

It is recommended to grant the unopposed petition to confirm assets to trust. (Prob. Code, § 850 et seq; *Estate of Heggstad* (1993) 16 Cal.App.4th 943.)
