

Probate Notes for October 6, 2015

Probate notes are a recommendation as to the outcome of the petition. Unlike tentative rulings, they do not automatically become adopted as the order of the court. Unless an appearance at the hearing is otherwise required by law, if petitioner submits a proposed order prior to the hearing and the recommendation is to grant the petition, no appearance is necessary. If you are scheduled to appear and there is no probate note issued in your case, you should appear as scheduled. If you wish to continue a matter, you must contact the civil division at (530) 406-6704, at least two (2) court days before your hearing.

CASE: Conservatorship of Kergel
Case No. CV PC 08-151

It is recommended to approve the court investigator's report. (Prob. Code, § 1850 et seq.)

CASE: Estate of Erhardt
Case No. CV PB 15-156

The parties are **DIRECTED TO APPEAR** for the continued hearing on Gretchen Brown's petition for probate of will and for letters testamentary as ordered by the Court on September 22, 2015.

CASE: Estate of Kaufman
Case No. CV PB 15-127

The parties are **DIRECTED TO APPEAR** to discuss whether to require a bond for the out of state proposed personal representative even though the will waives the bond. (Cal. Rules of Court, rule 7.201(b).)
