

## Probate Notes for October 8, 2015

Probate notes are a recommendation as to the outcome of the petition. Unlike tentative rulings, they do not automatically become adopted as the order of the court. Unless an appearance at the hearing is otherwise required by law, if petitioner submits a proposed order prior to the hearing and the recommendation is to grant the petition, no appearance is necessary. If you are scheduled to appear and there is no probate note issued in your case, you should appear as scheduled. If you wish to continue a matter, you must contact the civil division at (530) 406-6704, at least two (2) court days before your hearing.

**Please note:** The Yolo Superior Court is now located at 1000 Main Street, in Woodland. The following probate matters will be heard in **Department Eleven at 9:00 a.m.**

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**CASE:            Conservatorship of Rosenwald**  
**Case No. CV PC 09-176**

It is recommended to grant the petition to establish claim of ownership over personal property. (Prob. Code, § 850 et seq.)

**CASE:            Estate of Shakir**  
**Case No. CV PB 15-83**

It is recommended to grant the petition for an order citing Rahman (Abdul) Shakir to appear and be examined under oath pursuant Probate Code section 8870(a).

It is recommended to grant the spousal property petition as items 1 through 17 only. (Prob. Code, § 13650 et seq.)

The Court notes the following deficiency with Uzma Khalil's petition for administration: Proof of publication is required for the amended petition for letters of administration. (Cal. Rules of Court, rule 7.53(a), Prob. Code, § 8120 et seq.)

The Court notes the following deficiencies with Khuram Shakir's petition for administration:

1. The *Duties and Liabilities of Personal Representative* form must be filed with the Court (Judicial Council of California Form DE-147).
2. Proof of publication must be filed prior to the hearing. (Prob. Code, § 8120 et seq.)
3. Paragraph 3(g) of the petition is blank.
4. Paragraph 5(a) of the petition is incomplete.
