

Probate Notes for October 14, 2015

Probate notes are a recommendation as to the outcome of the petition. Unlike tentative rulings, they do not automatically become adopted as the order of the court. Unless an appearance at the hearing is otherwise required by law, if petitioner submits a proposed order prior to the hearing and the recommendation is to grant the petition, no appearance is necessary. If you are scheduled to appear and there is no probate note issued in your case, you should appear as scheduled. If you wish to continue a matter, you must contact the civil division at (530) 406-6704, at least two (2) court days before your hearing.

Please note: The Yolo Superior Court is now located at 1000 Main Street, in Woodland. The following probate matters will be heard in **Department Eleven at 9:00 a.m.**

CASE: Conservatorship of Barth
Case No. CV PC 14-192

The parties are **DIRECTED TO APPEAR** as ordered by the Court on September 10, 2015.

CASE: Conservatorship of Barth
Case No. CV PC 15-165

The Court notes the following deficiencies with Jordanne Young's petition for appointment of probate conservator of the estate:

1. Proof that the citation and petition were served on the proposed conservatee at least 15 days before the hearing has not been filed with the Court. (Prob. Code, § 1824.)
2. A *Confidential Supplemental Information* statement (form GC-312) has not been filed with the Court.

Additionally, on the Court's own motion the *Conservatorship of Barth*, case no. CV PC-15-165 is consolidated with the *Conservatorship of Barth*, case No. CV PC 14-192. Case no. CV PC 14-192 shall be designated as the lead case.

CASE: Conservatorship of Marshall
Case No. CV PB 98-189

It is recommended to approve the court investigator's report and seventh verified account and report of conservator. (Prob. Code, §§ 1850 et seq., 2620, 1060.)
