

## Probate Notes for December 4, 2015

Probate notes are a recommendation as to the outcome of the petition. Unlike tentative rulings, they do not automatically become adopted as the order of the court. Unless an appearance at the hearing is otherwise required by law, if petitioner submits a proposed order prior to the hearing and the recommendation is to grant the petition, no appearance is necessary. If you are scheduled to appear and there is no probate note issued in your case, you should appear as scheduled. If you wish to continue a matter, you must contact the civil division at (530) 406-6704, at least two (2) court days before your hearing.

**CASE:            Conservatorship of Anderson**  
**Case No. CV PC 08-01**

On the Court's own motion, the matter is **CONTINUED** to Friday, January 8, 2016, at 9:00 a.m. in Department 11 for completion of the court investigator's report.

**CASE:            Conservatorship of Anwar**  
**Case No. CV PC 14-194**

On the Court's own motion, the matter is **CONTINUED** to Friday, January 8, 2016, at 9:00 a.m. in Department 11 for completion of the court investigator's report.

**CASE:            Conservatorship of DeMartini**

The Court notes the following deficiency: the conservator failed to file the required accounting as ordered by the Court on December 6, 2013. (Prob. Code, § 2620.)

It is recommended to approve the court investigator's report. (Prob. Code, § 1850 et seq.)

It is recommended to approve the verified second account and report of conservator and to grant the petition for reappointment of conservator. (Welf. & Inst. Code, § 5350 et seq.)

It is recommended to approve the verified thirty-third account and report of conservator and to grant the petition for reappointment of conservator. (Welf. & Inst. Code, § 5350 et seq.)

The Court notes the following deficiencies:

1. The citation and copy of the petition were not served on the proposed conservatee at least 15 days before the hearing as required. (Prob. Code, § 1824.)
2. The notice of hearing was not served on the required parties at least 15 days before the hearing as required. (Prob. Code, § 1822.)

It is recommended to approve the verified eighteenth and final account and report of the conservator and petition for discharge of the LPS conservator of the person and estate. (Welf. & Inst. Code, § 5350 et seq.)

It is recommended to approve the verified ninth account and report of conservator and to grant the petition for reappointment of conservator. (Welf. & Inst. Code, § 5350 et seq.)
