

## Probate Notes for December 8, 2015

Probate notes are a recommendation as to the outcome of the petition. Unlike tentative rulings, they do not automatically become adopted as the order of the court. Unless an appearance at the hearing is otherwise required by law, if petitioner submits a proposed order prior to the hearing and the recommendation is to grant the petition, no appearance is necessary. If you are scheduled to appear and there is no probate note issued in your case, you should appear as scheduled. If you wish to continue a matter, you must contact the civil division at (530) 406-6704, at least two (2) court days before your hearing.

**CASE: Estate of Jones, Sr.  
Case No. CV PB 15-198**

The Court notes the following deficiencies:

1. Petitioner failed to file written bond waivers from each heir at law as alleged in paragraph 3(d) of the petition. (Prob. Code, § 8481.)
2. Proof of publication must be filed prior to the hearing. (Prob. Code, § 8120 et seq.)

**CASE: Estate of Privara  
Case No. CV PB 15-42**

It is recommended to grant the petition for final distribution on waiver of accounting, for allowance of statutory compensation to the attorney, and for final distribution and settlement of the estate. (Prob. Code, § 11600 et seq.)

**CASE: Estate of Saragoza  
Case No. CV PB 15-201**

The Court notes the following deficiencies:

1. Petitioner failed to file written bond waivers from each heir at law as alleged in paragraph 3(d) of the petition. (Prob. Code, § 8481.)
2. Proof of publication must be filed prior to the hearing. (Prob. Code, § 8120 et seq.)

**CASE: In the Matter of the Clary Separate Property Trust  
Case No. CV P2 15-187**

It is recommended to grant the unopposed petition to confirm assets to trust. (Prob. Code, § 850 et seq; *Estate of Heggstad* (1993) 16 Cal.App.4th 943.) Petitioner is directed to submit a proposed order prior to the date of the hearing.
