

Probate Notes for December 16, 2015

Probate notes are a recommendation as to the outcome of the petition. Unlike tentative rulings, they do not automatically become adopted as the order of the court. Unless an appearance at the hearing is otherwise required by law, if petitioner submits a proposed order prior to the hearing and the recommendation is to grant the petition, no appearance is necessary. If you are scheduled to appear and there is no probate note issued in your case, you should appear as scheduled. If you wish to continue a matter, you must contact the civil division at (530) 406-6704, at least two (2) court days before your hearing.

Please note: The Yolo Superior Court is now located at 1000 Main Street, in Woodland. The following probate matters will be heard in **Department Eleven at 9:00 a.m.**

CASE: Conservatorship of Irmischer
Case No. CV PC 91-19801

Due to the death of the conservatee, the conservatorship of the person terminated, by operation of law, December 5, 2013.

It is recommended to approve the verified first and final account and report of the conservator and to grant the petition for discharge upon the filing of a final declaration with the Court showing that the remaining estate assets, if any, have been properly delivered. (Prob. Code, §§ 2467, 2620 et seq.)

CASE: Estate of Mosier
Case No. CV PB 15-191

The parties are **DIRECTED TO APPEAR** for the continued hearing on Tasha Commick's petition for probate of will and for letters testamentary as ordered by the Court on December 9, 2015.
