Defendant City of Davis's demurrer to the first and second causes of action is **OVERRULED**. (Code Civ. Proc., § 430.10, subd. (e).) Its demurrer to the third cause of action is **SUSTAINED WITH LEAVE TO AMEND**. (Code Civ. Proc., § 430.10, subd. (e).) Plaintiff fails to describe the basis for defendant's alleged liability for this cause of action.
