Case: **Johnson v. Schwent**

Plaintiff Bettie Jo Johnson's unopposed motion to compel responses to form and special interrogatories is **GRANTED**. (Code Civ. Proc., § 2030.290, subd. (b).) Defendant Vincent Schwent shall serve verified answers to the interrogatories, without objections, by July 22, 2014.

Plaintiff's request for sanctions is **DENIED**. (Code Civ. Proc., § 2023.040.) Plaintiff's notice of motion fails specify the type of sanction sought, and fails to identify the person, party, and/or attorney against whom the sanctions are sought.
