**TENTATIVE RULING**

**Case:** Cach, LLC v. Engler  
Case No. CV G 09-2995

**Hearing Date:** August 26, 2014 Department Two 9:00 a.m.

Defendant Michael J. Engler's motion to set aside default judgment is **DENIED**. (Code Civ. Proc., § 473.5.) Default judgment was entered on April 15, 2010. Defendant's motion is untimely as the notice of motion was served and filed more than two years after the default judgment was entered against defendant. (Code Civ. Proc., § 473.5, subd. (a).)

The notice of motion does not provide notice of the Court's tentative ruling system as required by Local Rule 11.4(b). Counsel for moving party is ordered to notify the opposing party or parties immediately of the tentative ruling system and to be available at the hearing, in person or by telephone, in the event the opposing party or parties appear without following the procedures set forth in Local Rule 11.4(a).
