Plaintiff Jessie Esio's application for a right to attach order and writ of attachment is **DENIED**.
No proof of service of the summons and complaint on defendant has been filed. (Code civ. Proc., § 484.040, subd. (a).)

Plaintiff James Martinez's motion to appoint counsel is **DROPPED FROM CALENDAR**.
There is no proof of service of the motion on defendant City of Davis filed with the Court. (Code Civ. Proc., § 1013.)

Plaintiff's motion to compel is **DROPPED FROM CALENDAR**. It was not served and filed at least 16 court days before the hearing date. (Code Civ. Proc., § 1005.)
