TENTATIVE RULING

Case: Coyle v. Bowels
Case No. CV UD 14-1312
Hearing Date: October 15, 2014 Department Seven 9:00 a.m.

Plaintiff Christopher Coyle's unopposed motion for summary judgment is **GRANTED**. Plaintiff establishes that there is no triable issue as to any material fact and he is entitled to judgment as a matter of law. (Code Civ. Proc., §§ 437c, 1170.7; Cal. Rules of Court, rule 3.1351; *Aguilar v. Atlantic Richfield Company* (2001) 25 Cal.4th 826, 853; *Troyk v. Farmers Grp., Inc.* (2009) 171 Cal.App.4th 1305, 1321; Plaintiff's Separate Statement of Undisputed Material Facts Nos. 1-7; Decl. of Fred Martinez, ¶¶ 1-5; Decl. of Christopher Coyle, ¶¶ 1-8.)

If no hearing is requested, plaintiff is directed to prepare a formal order consistent with this ruling and in accordance with Code of Civil Procedure section 437c(g) and California Rule of Court 3.1312.

Case: EGC Financial, LLC v. Jensen
Case No. CV G 14-89
Hearing Date: October 15, 2014 Department Two 9:00 a.m.

Plaintiff EGC Financial, LLC's motion for judgment on the pleadings is **DROPPED FROM CALENDAR**. The proof of service attached to the motion states that the moving papers were served on October 8, 2014. This is insufficient notice under Code of Civil Procedure section 1005.

If no hearing is requested, this tentative ruling is effective immediately. No formal order pursuant to California Rule of Court 3.1312, or further notice is required.
