Defendant Angel Licea's motion to compel a second independent medical examination is **GRANTED**. (Code Civ. Proc., § 2032.320, subd. (a).) After the first independent medical examination, plaintiff has undergone two surgeries to the areas for which he claims damages in this action, and has improved in part because of one of those surgeries. Accordingly, good cause for a second independent medical examination has been shown.
