The hearing on plaintiffs Gary and Vanessa Jacobs's motion for an interlocutory judgment of partition is **CONTINUED** on the Court's own motion to be heard on February 19, 2015, at 9:00 a.m. in Department 2. Plaintiffs and defendants have respectively submitted their own proposed orders on the motion. The proposed orders differ in several respects. The parties are directed to meet and confer, and submit to the Court one proposed order that contains the provisions on which the parties agree. If the parties' proposed versions of any paragraph of the order differ, the proposed order shall contain each version of the proposed paragraph, one immediately after the other. If two versions of any one paragraph are submitted, each party shall submit a separate brief stating the legal and factual reasons that their proposed paragraph should be adopted by the Court. The Court will issue a tentative ruling setting forth the selected provisions.
