Case: Kurowski v. City of West Sacramento
Case No. CV PM 12-2457
Hearing Date: February 6, 2015 Department Two 9:00 a.m.

Plaintiff Thomas Kurowski's motion for leave to file an amended complaint is **DENIED**. (Code Civ. Proc., § 473, subd. (a)(1); Cal. Rules of Court, rule 3.1324.) Given the dates plaintiff provides regarding when the new information was discovered, plaintiff fails to justify why amendment was not sought earlier, and defendants have established prejudice given the proximity of trial. (*Morgan v. Sup. Ct.* (1959) 172 Cal.App.2d 527, 530; *Mabie v. Hyatt* (1998) 61 Cal.App.4th 581, 596.)

If no hearing is requested, this tentative ruling is effective immediately. No formal order pursuant to California Rule of Court 3.1312, or further notice is required.
