Daniela M. Pavone and Theta Omega Association's demurrer is **DROPPED FROM CALENDAR**. Plaintiff filed a first amended complaint on March 12, 2015. (Code Civ. Proc., § 472.) As there is but one complaint in a civil action, the filing of an amended complaint moots all motions directed to the prior complaint. (*Sylmar Air Conditioning v. Pueblo Contracting Servs., Inc.* (2004) 122 Cal.App.4th 1049, 1054.)
