**TENTATIVE RULING**

**Case:** Fontanetti v. Puumala  
Case No. CV UD 15-468  
**Hearing Date:** May 14, 2015 Department Two 9:00 a.m.

Defendant Lacey Puumala's unopposed motion to quash service of summons is **GRANTED**. (Code Civ. Proc., §§ 418.10; 1167.4; Cal. Rules of Court, rules 3.36(b), 3.1327.) Defendant submits evidence to establish she was not personally served with the amended summons and complaint on April 28, 2015. (Decl. of Lacey Puumala, ¶¶ 1-5; Decl. of Nora Roos, ¶¶ 1-4; *Bolkiah v. Superior Court* (1999) 74 Cal.App.4th 984, 991.) Papers in the case must be served on both the attorney providing the limited scope representation and the defendant directly. (Cal. Rules of Court, rule 3.36(b).)

If no hearing is requested, this tentative ruling is effective immediately. No formal order pursuant to California Rule of Court 3.1312, or further notice is required.

**TENTATIVE RULING**

**Case:** Herndon v. Carrion  
Case No. CV PM 15-419  
**Hearing Date:** May 14, 2015 Department Two 9:00 a.m.

Defendants County of Yolo and Debbie Carrion's demurrer to plaintiff Lubertha Herndon's complaint is **SUSTAINED WITH LEAVE TO AMEND**. (Code Civ. Proc., § 430.10, subd. (e).) Plaintiff fails to state facts sufficient to support a cause of action against defendants.
