

Probate Notes for May 28, 2015

Probate notes are a recommendation as to the outcome of the petition. Unlike tentative rulings, they do not automatically become adopted as the order of the court. Unless an appearance at the hearing is otherwise required by law, if petitioner submits a proposed order prior to the hearing and the recommendation is to grant the petition, no appearance is necessary. If you are scheduled to appear and there is no probate note issued in your case, you should appear as scheduled. If you wish to continue a matter, you must contact the civil division at (530) 406-6704, at least two (2) court days before your hearing.

Please note: The following probate matters will be heard in **Department Two at 9:00 a.m.**

CASE: Conservatorship of Barth
Case No. CV PC 14-192

The parties are **DIRECTED TO APPEAR** for the hearing to appoint counsel for the proposed conservatee as ordered by Court on April 28, 2015.

CASE: Estate of Stone
Case No. CV PB 14-210

On the Court's own motion, the matter is **CONTINUED** to Thursday, June 10, 2015, at 9:00 a.m. in Department 2 so that the Court may more thoroughly consider the petition filed by Anna Adams.
