Case: **Grill v. Meritage Homes of Calif., Inc.**

Defendant Meritage Homes of California, Inc.'s request for judicial notice is **GRANTED**. (Evid. Code, § 452, subd. (d).)

Defendant's motion for leave to amend its cross-complaint to add MKM & Associates, Harris & Sloan Consulting Group, Inc., and OAG Architects, Inc. is **GRANTED**. (Code Civ. Proc., § 473, subd. (a)(1).) Discovery cut-offs, including the expert witness discovery cut-off, will now expire by reference to any re-set trial date. Only these cross-defendants shall be permitted to conduct further discovery.

If no hearing is requested, this tentative ruling is effective immediately. No formal order pursuant to California Rule of Court 3.1312 or further notice is required.
