Defendants Kathy Ann Donnelly and Jennifer Cundiff's petition to compel arbitration is **GRANTED**. (Code Civ. Proc., § 1281.2; *Thomas v. Westlake* (2012) 204 Cal.App.4th 605, 614-15; *Westra v. Marcus & Millichap Real Estate Inv. Brokerage Co., Inc.* (2005) 129 Cal.App.4th 759, 766; *Dryer v. Los Angeles Rams* (1985) 40 Cal.3d 406, 418.)
