TENTATIVE RULING

Case: **Center City Automotive, Inc. v. Watt**
Case No. CV CV 15-1131

Hearing Date: **October 15, 2015** **Department Eleven** **9:00 a.m.**

Defendant Clifford Watt's motion to quash is **DENIED**. (Code Civ. Proc., § 418.10.) Plaintiff has alleged sufficient facts to support the exercise of specific personal jurisdiction over defendant. (*Taylor-Bush v. Multitech Corp.* (1990) 217 Cal.App.3d 103.)

Plaintiff Center City Automotive, Inc.'s motion for a preliminary injunction is **DENIED**. (Code Civ. Proc., § 526.) Plaintiff has not established with sufficient evidence that it will prevail on the merits. (*Fleishman v. Superior Court* (2002) 102 Cal.App.4th 350, 355.)

The notice of motion does not provide notice of this Court's tentative ruling system as required by Local Rule 11.4(b). Counsel for moving party is ordered to notify the opposing party or parties immediately of the tentative ruling system and to be available at the hearing, in person or by telephone, in the event the opposing party or parties appear without following the procedures set forth in Local Rule 11.4(a).
