**TENTATIVE RULING**

**Case: Doe v. Regents of the Univ. of Calif.  
Case No. CV PT 15-1334**  
**Hearing Date: December 9, 2015 Department Eleven 9:00 a.m.**

Petitioner John Doe's petition for writ of prohibition or other extraordinary relief is **DENIED**. (Code Civ. Proc., §§ 1102, 1103.) Petitioner fails to show that respondent acted without or in excess of its jurisdiction.

The notice of motion does not provide notice of this Court's tentative ruling system as required by Local Rule 11.4(b). (Code of Civ. Proc., §§ 415.10, 1094.5, 1096.) Additionally, petitioner failed to file or lodge the administrative record with the Court. (Cal. Rules of Court, rule 3.1140.) Petitioner also failed to attach any of the referenced exhibits to his petition.
