Case: Nesbitt v. Warhover
Case No. CV PO 13-460
Hearing Date: December 10, 2015 Department Eleven 9:00 a.m.

Plaintiff Kevin Nesbitt's motion to tax costs is **GRANTED**, as to courier services in the amount of \$727.38. Plaintiff fails to justify the expense in light of cheaper alternatives. (Code Civ. Proc., § 1033.5, subd. (c)(4).) It is **DENIED** as to the remainder of the cost items. (Code Civ. Proc., § 1033.5, subds. (a)(1), (a)(4).)

Case: Singh v. Sangha
Case No. CV CV 15-1143
Hearing Date: December 10, 2015 Department Eleven 9:00 a.m.

Plaintiff Gurdev Singh's motion for a preliminary injunction is **DENIED**. (Code Civ. Proc., §§ 526, 527, subd. (a).) Plaintiff fails to establish that it is reasonably probable that he will prevail on the merits at trial. (*San Francisco Newspaper Printing Co., Inc. v. Sup.Ct.* (Miller) (1985) 170 Cal.App.3d 438, 442; *O'Connell v. Superior Court* (2006) 141 Cal.App.4th 1452, 1481.)
