Petitioner Michael L. Kendrick's motion for a new mediator and motion "to assign or post amount of judgment of December 8, 2005," is **DENIED**. It does not contain the required memorandum of points and authorities. (Cal. Rules of Court, rule 3.1113.)

Respondent Larry Weltch's motion to vacate the renewal of judgment, which attempts to prevent the relief sought by the above-referenced motion, is **DENIED AS MOOT**.

If no hearing is requested, this tentative ruling is effective immediately. No formal order pursuant to California Rule of Court 3.1312, or further notice is required.

If the parties fail to appear at the hearing and the Court has not excused their personal appearance, the petition will be denied without prejudice. No request for a hearing is required.
