TENTATIVE RULING

Case: **Singh v. Sangha**
Case No. CV CV 15-1143
Hearing Date: **February 26, 2016** **Department Eleven** **9:00 a.m.**

Defendants Amarjit Singh Sangha, G & S Gasoline, Inc., and Reno's Mega Mart's and plaintiff Gurdev Singh's requests for judicial notice are **GRANTED**. (Evid. Code, § 452, subd. (d).)

Plaintiff's motion to appoint a receiver and/or a provisional director is **DENIED**. Plaintiff cites no legal authority in his supplemental memorandum supporting the appointment of a provisional director. Plaintiff has not shown that property is in danger of being lost, removed, or materially injured, or that plaintiff will suffer irreparable injury if a receiver is not appointed. (Code Civ. Proc., § 564, subd. (b)(1); *Moore v. Oberg* (1943) 61 Cal.App.2d 216, 222.)

If no hearing is requested, this tentative ruling is effective immediately. No formal order pursuant to California Rule of Court 3.1312, or further notice is required.
