**TENTATIVE RULING**

**Case:** **Allied Property and Casualty Ins. Co. v. Ramirez**  
**Case No. CV CV 14-1820**  
**Hearing Date:** **March 29, 2016** **Department Eleven** **9:00 a.m.**

Plaintiff Allied Property and Casualty Company's unopposed motion to compel defendant Maria Ramirez to provide verified responses to form interrogatories, without objections, is **GRANTED**. (Code Civ. Proc., § 2030.290, subd. (a).) Monetary sanctions are granted against defendant Ramirez in the amount of \$310.00. (Code Civ. Proc., § 2030.290, subd. (c).)

The Court encourages counsel for plaintiff to verify that moving papers submitted on behalf of plaintiff contain correct citations to the law. Each of the citations in the moving papers has been outdated for over ten (10) years since the passage of AB 3081.

The notice of motion does not provide notice of this Court's tentative ruling system as required by Local Rule 11.4(b). Counsel for moving party is ordered to notify the opposing party or parties immediately of the tentative ruling system and to be available at the hearing, in person or by telephone, in the event the opposing party or parties appear without following the procedures set forth in Local Rule 11.4(a).
