The requests for judicial notice are **GRANTED**. (Evid. Code, § 452, subd. (c); *Friends of Shingle Springs Interchange, Inc. v. City of El Dorado* (2011) 200 Cal.App.4th 1470, 1483-1484.)

Respondent Yolo County District Attorney's Office's demurrer to petitioners David Greenwald and the People's Vanguard of Davis's ("Vanguard") verified amended petition is **SUSTAINED**

WITH LEAVE TO AMEND as to Vanguard only. (Code Civ. Proc., § 430.10, subd. (b).)

Based on the documents attached to the verified petition filed on July 27, 2015, the Public Records Act requests at issue were made by petitioner David Greenwald only. (Verified Petition filed July 27, 2015, Exh. 1; *Brakke v. Economic Concepts, Inc.* (2013) 213 Cal.App.4th 761, 767; *Berg & Berg Enterprises, LLC v. Boyle* (2009) 178 Cal.App.4th 1020, 1034.)

Petitioners' request for sanctions is **DENIED**.
