Plaintiffs Thomas Costa and Gwendolyn Costa's motion to quash or, in the alternative, motion for a protective order, relating to a subpoena served on plaintiffs' counsel, Jamil White, is **DENIED**. Defendant Raymond Contreras dba Tony's Cocktails has shown good cause for taking counsel's deposition. (*Spectra-Physics, Inc. v. Superior Court* (1988) 198 Cal.App.3d 1487.)
