Defendant County of Yolo's unopposed motion to quash plaintiff Conaway Preservation Group, LLC's notice to appear and produce documents at trial is **GRANTED**. (Code Civ. Proc., § 1987.1.) Plaintiff has not shown that Arthur Gimmy and/or David Schwenger are among the persons who may be compelled to appear by the means set forth in Code of Civil Procedure section 1987(b).

If no hearing is requested, this tentative ruling is effective immediately. No formal order pursuant to California Rule of Court 3.1312, or further notice is required.
