Defendants Food 4 Less and Nugget Market, Inc.'s unopposed motion to compel responses to form interrogatories, sets one, special interrogatories, set one, and request for production of documents, set one is **GRANTED**. (Code Civ. Proc., §§ 2030.290, subd. (b), 2031.300, subd. (b).) Plaintiff Yaneth Romero shall serve verified answers to the form and special interrogatories and requests for production of documents, together with all responsive documents, without objections, by August 8, 2016.

Defendants' unopposed request for monetary sanctions against plaintiff is **GRANTED IN PART** in the amount of \$294.00. (Code Civ. Proc., §§ 2023.010 et seq., 2030.290, subd. (c), 2031.300, subd. (c); Decl. of Geraldine P. Barrows, ¶ 11.) Sanctions are not granted for time not yet incurred. Plaintiff shall pay the monetary sanctions to defendants by August 8, 2016.

If no hearing is requested, this tentative ruling is effective immediately. No formal order pursuant to California Rule of Court 3.1312, or further notice is required.
