Defendant Teresa Isabel Perea's unopposed motion to continue the trial set for October 3, 2016, is **GRANTED**. (Cal. Rules of Court, rule 3.1332.)

The trial date of October 3, 2016, and trial readiness conference date of September 12, 2016, are **VACATED**. The parties are directed to appear at a case management conference on Monday, September 12, 2016, in Department 6 at 9:00 a.m. to reset the trial.

Defendant's request to continue the discovery deadlines to correspond with the new trial date is **GRANTED** based on the written agreement of the parties. (Decl. of Terrence T. Snook, ¶ 4, Exh. A; Code Civ. Proc., § 2024.060.)
