Case: **Crum v. Kaur**

Defendant Anmol Kaur's unopposed motion to compel responses to form interrogatories, set one, special interrogatories, set one, and request for production of documents, set one is **GRANTED**. (Code Civ. Proc., §§ 2030.290, subd. (b), 2031.300, subd. (b); Ins. Code, § 11580.2.) Plaintiff Laura Crum shall serve verified responses to the form and special interrogatories and requests for production of documents, together with all responsive documents, without objections, by November 14, 2016.

Defendant's request for sanctions is **DENIED**. Defendant's notice of motion fails to identify the person, party, and/or attorney against whom the monetary sanctions are sought. (Code Civ. Proc., § 2023.040.)

If no hearing is requested, this tentative ruling is effective immediately. No formal order pursuant to California Rule of Court 3.1312, or further notice is required.

Plaintiff State Farm General Insurance Company's unopposed motion to set aside the dismissal entered by the Court on February 8, 2016 is **GRANTED**. (Code Civ. Proc., § 473, subd. (b); Decl. of Lee M. Mendelson, ¶¶ 1-9.) The parties are directed to appear at a case management conference on Monday, November 14, 2016, in Department 6 at 9:00 a.m.
