

## Probate Notes for January 22, 2016

Probate notes are a recommendation as to the outcome of the petition. Unlike tentative rulings, they do not automatically become adopted as the order of the court. Unless an appearance at the hearing is otherwise required by law, if petitioner submits a proposed order prior to the hearing and the recommendation is to grant the petition, no appearance is necessary. If you are scheduled to appear and there is no probate note issued in your case, you should appear as scheduled. If you wish to continue a matter, you must contact the civil division at (530) 406-6704, at least two (2) court days before your hearing.

**CASE:            Conservatorship of Marshall  
                      Case No. CV PB 98-189**

It is recommended to grant the amended petition for appointment of successor conservator of the estate. (Prob. Code, § 2680 et seq.) It is also recommended to grant the petitions to: 1) waive bond, 2) waive future accountings, and 3) authorize the conservator to pay the conservatee's monthly expenses. (Prob. Code. §§ 2320, et seq, 2628.)

The parties are **DIRECTED TO APPEAR** to discuss the petition for instructions regarding allowance to the conservatee.
