

Probate Notes for January 27, 2016

Probate notes are a recommendation as to the outcome of the petition. Unlike tentative rulings, they do not automatically become adopted as the order of the court. Unless an appearance at the hearing is otherwise required by law, if petitioner submits a proposed order prior to the hearing and the recommendation is to grant the petition, no appearance is necessary. If you are scheduled to appear and there is no probate note issued in your case, you should appear as scheduled. If you wish to continue a matter, you must contact the civil division at (530) 406-6704, at least two (2) court days before your hearing.

Please note: The Yolo Superior Court is now located at 1000 Main Street, in Woodland. The following probate matters will be heard in **Department Eleven at 9:00 a.m.**

CASE: Estate of Becket
Case No. CV PB 15-227

If petitioner files proof that the declaration filed on January 19, 2016, was served on all parties as required, it is recommended to grant the petition for probate of will and letters testamentary and for authorization to administer the estate under the Independent Administration of Estates Act. (Prob. Code, § 8200.)

CASE: Estate of Buckley
Case No. CV PB 15-242

The Court notes the following deficiency: The *Duties and Liabilities of Personal Representative* form must be filed with the Court (Judicial Council of California Form DE-147).

CASE: Estate of Snyder
Case No. CV PB 14-165

It is recommended to grant the petition for first and final account and report of executor and for final distribution and settlement of the estate. (Prob. Code, § 11600 et seq.)
