

Probate Notes for January 28, 2016

Probate notes are a recommendation as to the outcome of the petition. Unlike tentative rulings, they do not automatically become adopted as the order of the court. Unless an appearance at the hearing is otherwise required by law, if petitioner submits a proposed order prior to the hearing and the recommendation is to grant the petition, no appearance is necessary. If you are scheduled to appear and there is no probate note issued in your case, you should appear as scheduled. If you wish to continue a matter, you must contact the civil division at (530) 406-6704, at least two (2) court days before your hearing.

Please note: The Yolo Superior Court is now located at 1000 Main Street, in Woodland. The following probate matters will be heard in **Department Eleven at 9:00 a.m.**

**CASE: Estate of Gonzalez, Sr.
Case No. CV PB 14-200**

It is recommended to grant the petition for final distribution on waiver of accounting, for allowance of statutory compensation to the attorney and administrator for ordinary services, for extraordinary fees, for authorization to withhold a reserve fund, and for final distribution and settlement of the estate. (Prob. Code, § 11600 et seq.)

**CASE: Estate of Ringcamp
Case No. CV PB 14-179**

The parties are hereby notified that the Court will issue a tentative ruling no later than 2:00 p.m. on Wednesday, January 27, 2016, pursuant to Local Rule 11.4, on Brian Scaccia's motion for reconsideration.

**CASE: In re the Matter of the Judkins Special needs Trust
Case No. CV P2 14-52**

It is recommended to approve the first account and report of trustee and grant the petitions for: 1) trustee and attorney's fees, 2) reduction of bond, and 3) transfer of proceedings to Sacramento County. (Prob. Code, §§ 17200 et seq.)
