

## Probate Notes for January 6, 2016

Probate notes are a recommendation as to the outcome of the petition. Unlike tentative rulings, they do not automatically become adopted as the order of the court. Unless an appearance at the hearing is otherwise required by law, if petitioner submits a proposed order prior to the hearing and the recommendation is to grant the petition, no appearance is necessary. If you are scheduled to appear and there is no probate note issued in your case, you should appear as scheduled. If you wish to continue a matter, you must contact the civil division at (530) 406-6704, at least two (2) court days before your hearing.

**CASE:            Conservatorship of Cardenas**  
**Case No. CV PC 15-200**

On the Court's own motion, the matter is **CONTINUED** to Wednesday, February 10, 2016, at 9:00 a.m. in Department 11 for completion of the court investigator's report.

**CASE:            Conservatorship of Vann**  
**Case No. CV PC 14-158**

The parties are **DIRECTED TO APPEAR** for the continued hearing as ordered by the Court on December 12, 2015.

**CASE:            Estate of Becket**  
**Case No. CV PB 15-227**

The Court notes the following deficiencies:

1. Proof of publication must be filed prior to the hearing. (Prob. Code, § 8120 et seq.)
2. Petitioner has failed to submit substantial evidence to overcome the presumption of revocation by destruction. (Prob. Code, § 6124; *Lauermann v. Superior Court* (2005) 127 Cal.App.4th 1327; *Estate of Obernolte* (1979) 91 Cal.App.3d 124.)

**CASE:            Estate of Mosier**  
**Case No. CV PB 15-191**

The parties are **DIRECTED TO APPEAR** for the continued hearing on Tasha Commick's petition for probate of will and for letters testamentary as ordered by the Court on December 16, 2015.

**CASE:            Estate of Persons**  
**Case No. CV PB 15-216**

The Court notes the following deficiency: The *Duties and Liabilities of Personal Representative* form must be filed with the Court (Judicial Council of California Form DE-

147). Additionally, petitioner is directed to submit a proposed order prior to the date of the hearing.

**CASE: Estate of Saragoza  
Case No. CV PB 15-201**

The Court notes the following deficiency: Petitioner failed to file written bond waivers from each heir at law as alleged in paragraph 3(d) of the petition. (Prob. Code, § 8481.) Specifically, petitioner has failed to file a written bond waiver by Tina Gottlieb.

**CASE: In the Matter of the Ammons Trust  
Case No. CV P2 15-217**

On the Court's own motion, the matter is **CONTINUED** to Wednesday, January 13, 2016, at 9:00 a.m. in Department 11 so that the Court may more thoroughly consider the petition filed by Tracy Ammons.
