

Probate Notes for October 11, 2016

Probate notes are a recommendation as to the outcome of the petition. Unlike tentative rulings, they do not automatically become adopted as the order of the court. Unless an appearance at the hearing is otherwise required by law, if petitioner submits a proposed order prior to the hearing and the recommendation is to grant the petition, no appearance is necessary. If you are scheduled to appear and there is no probate note issued in your case, you should appear as scheduled. If you wish to continue a matter, you must contact the civil division at (530) 406-6704, at least two (2) court days before your hearing.

Please note: The Yolo Superior Court is now located at 1000 Main Street, in Woodland. The following probate matters will be heard in **Department Eleven at 9:00 a.m.**

CASE: Conservatorship of Levine
Case No. CV PB 16-132

The parties are **DIRECTED TO APPEAR.**

CASE: Conservatorship of Odenweller
Case No. CV PC 15-112

It is recommended to approve the court investigator's report. (Prob. Code, § 1850 et seq.)

CASE: Estate of Bowsbey
Case No. CV PB 76-14692

It is recommended the grant the unopposed verified petition to appoint successor trustees. (Prob. Code, §§ 17200, 17203, 1211.)

CASE: Estate of Lopez
Case No. CV PB 15-207

The Court notes the following deficiency: The *Notice of Hearing* filed on September 12, 2016, fails to state that compensation for the personal representative or the attorney for the personal representative is being requested as required. (Prob. Code, § 11000, subd. (b).)

CASE: In the Matter of the Helen B. Harris Trust
Case No. CV P2 16-141

It is recommended to grant the unopposed petition to confirm assets to trust. (Prob. Code, § 850 et seq; *Estate of Heggstad* (1993) 16 Cal.App.4th 943.) It is also recommended to grant the unopposed petition to appoint successor trustee. (Prob. Code, § 17200 et seq.)
