

## Probate Notes for October 21, 2016

Probate notes are a recommendation as to the outcome of the petition. Unlike tentative rulings, they do not automatically become adopted as the order of the court. Unless an appearance at the hearing is otherwise required by law, if petitioner submits a proposed order prior to the hearing and the recommendation is to grant the petition, no appearance is necessary. If you are scheduled to appear and there is no probate note issued in your case, you should appear as scheduled. If you wish to continue a matter, you must contact the civil division at (530) 406-6704, at least two (2) court days before your hearing.

**CASE:            Conservatorship of Kemnitz  
                    Case No. CV PC 12-32**

It is recommended to deny Rachel Wilkerson's petition for appointment of successor probate conservator. There is no vacancy in the office of the conservator. (Prob. Code, § 2680.) Additionally, the petitioner has failed to file with the Court an acknowledgment of receipt of the Duties of Conservator and Acknowledgement of Receipt of Handbook form. (Prob. Code, § 1834; Cal. Rules of Court, rule 7.1051.)

The parties are **DIRECTED TO APPEAR** for the continued hearing as ordered by the Court on August 19, 2016.

**CASE:            Conservatorship of Tegenfeldt  
                    Case No. CV PC 16-125  
                    Hearing date: October 21, 2016**

The Court notes the following deficiency: A confidential written report of the regional center's findings and recommendations must be filed with the Court. (Prob. Code, § 1827.5.) The regional center's report must also be mailed, at least five days prior to the hearing, to the proposed conservatee and the petitioner, or attorney of the petitioner. (*Ibid.*)

On the Court's own motion, the matter is **CONTINUED** to Friday, November 19, 2016, at 9:00 a.m. in Department 11 for completion of the court investigator's report.

It is recommended to grant the petition for an order authorizing medical treatment for the conservatee. (Welf. & Inst. Code, § 5358.2.)

**CASE:            LPS Conservatorship of Crites  
                    Case No. LP SQ 13-32**

It is recommended to approve the verified third account and report of conservator and to grant the petition for reappointment of conservator. (Welf. & Inst. Code, § 5350 et seq.)

**CASE: LPS Conservatorship of Hutton  
Case No. LP SQ 12-32**

It is recommended to approve the verified fourth and final account and report of the conservator and petition for discharge of the LPS conservator of the person and estate. (Welf. & Inst. Code, § 5350 et seq.)

**CASE: LPS Conservatorship of Johnston  
Case No. CV LP SQ 16-44**

The request for judicial notice is granted. (Evid. Code, § 452, subd. (d).)

It is recommended to grant the petition for appointment of Murphy Conservatorship of the person and estate. (Welf. & Inst. Code, §§ 5008, 5350 et seq.)

**CASE: LPS Conservatorship of McPherson  
Case No. CV PB 89-19438**

It is recommended to approve the verified twenty-seventh and final account and report of the conservator and petition for discharge of the LPS conservator of the person and estate. (Welf. & Inst. Code, § 5350 et seq.)
