

Probate Notes for October 3, 2016

Probate notes are a recommendation as to the outcome of the petition. Unlike tentative rulings, they do not automatically become adopted as the order of the court. Unless an appearance at the hearing is otherwise required by law, if petitioner submits a proposed order prior to the hearing and the recommendation is to grant the petition, no appearance is necessary. If you are scheduled to appear and there is no probate note issued in your case, you should appear as scheduled. If you wish to continue a matter, you must contact the civil division at (530) 406-6704, at least two (2) court days before your hearing.

CASE: Conservatorship of Robb
Case No. CV PC 16-131

The Court notes the following deficiency: The conservatee is not represented by an attorney. (Prob. Code, §§ 2356.5, subd. (f)(1), 1470 et seq.)

CASE: Estate of Persons
Case No. CV PB 15-216

It is recommended to approve the first and final account and report of executor, and to grant the petition for allowance of statutory compensation to the executor and attorney for ordinary services, and for final distribution and settlement of the estate. (Prob. Code, § 11600 et seq.)
